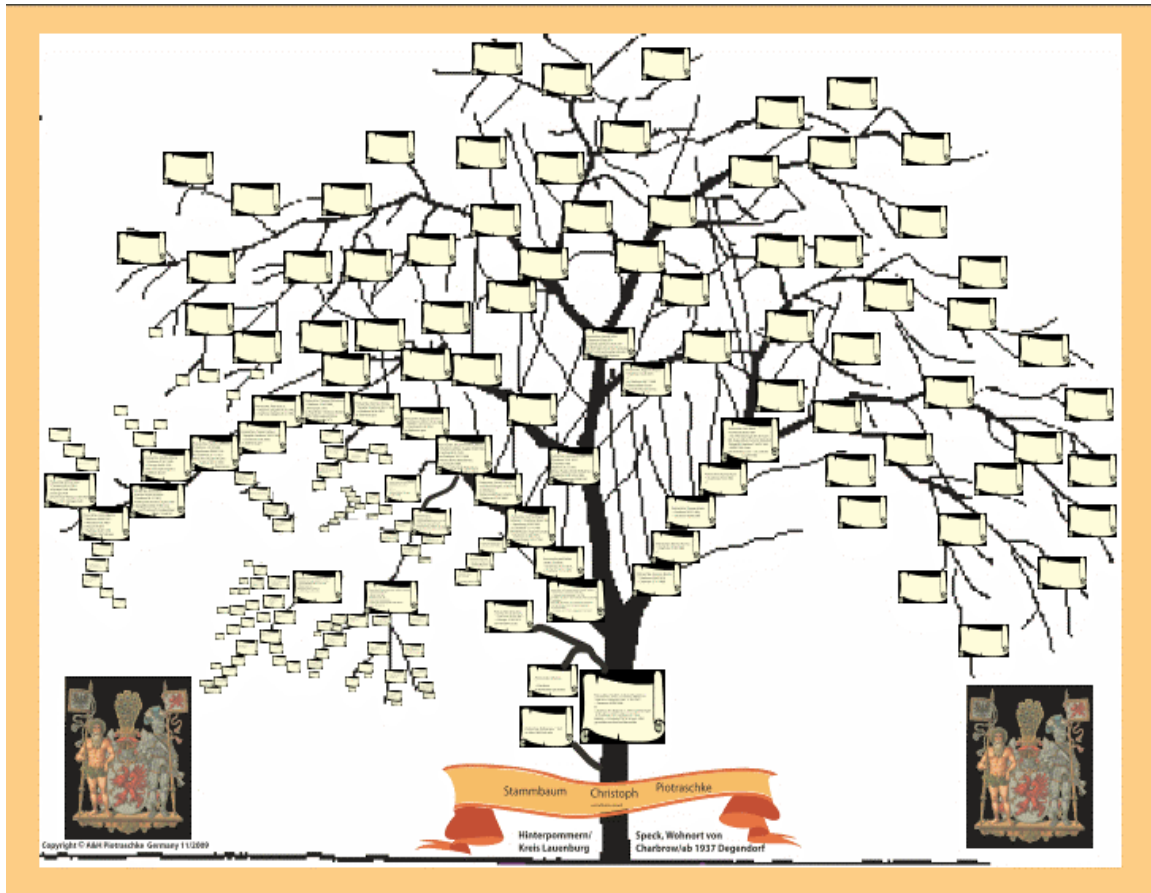

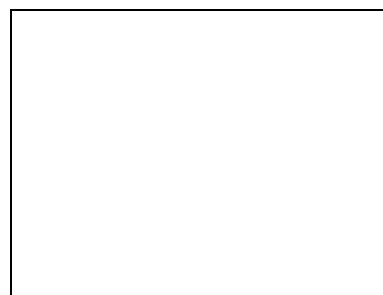

Many family members living today have seen their parents farm, using horse drawn equipment, rode in Model T's, and danced to the "50's & 60's"



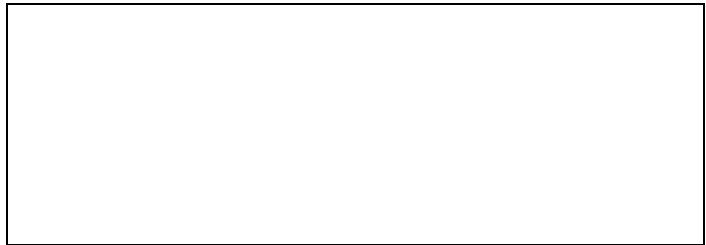
