Memories of Betty (Piotraschke) Oelzen

My dad talked about as a young man he would pick strawberries on the farm. There was also gooseberries and peach trees. Probably apple trees and grapes. I would go in the barn and orind corn for the chickens. There was also a pond near the barn. My dad, Fred, and I would go visit my grandfather every Saturday and he would have dried apples waiting for me in the window. My dad and grandpa would talk in German the whole time we were there. He died when I was 10 - pneumonia. I would usually go outside and yell for my cousin, Helen, (Uncle Henry's daughter), who lived on adjoining property, to come over.




